Entrance to School

Kindergarten

A child may enter kindergarten in September if s/he will be five years old on or before December 1st of the school year. Kindergarten registration will be held in March. Parents of pre-school-age children, who are on the school census, are notified of time and place of registration. All others should come to the Census & Enrollment Office at the Howitt Middle School to prove residency and be put on the school census.

First Grade

A child who has had a full year of kindergarten in an approved school will be admitted to the first grade. Students who are six years old and have not attended kindergarten will be entered initially into kindergarten and advanced according to ability.

New and Transfer Students

During the school year, new residents are admitted at the District Census and Enrollment Office located in the Howitt Middle School (Grant Avenue entrance) Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 3:30 pm. During the summer, enrollment hours are Monday through Thursday, 8 am to 2 pm, and Friday from 8 am to 11 am.

Proof of residency (see website for acceptable proof) and original birth certificate are required for registation. For school age children, mandated immunizations (see below), health records and prior school report card are also required for registration. Additional enrollment information is available on our website listed under "Our District" then "District Census and Enrollment Office."

Special Education

Special education services and programs are provided to students with disabilities pursuant to applicable federal and state laws. Any parent or person in parental relation who suspects that his/her child has a disability may refer their child for an evaluation by the District's Committee on Special Education (CSE) or Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) for eligibility for special education services and programs. More detailed information on this process is available in *A Parent's Guide to Special Education*, which is published on the NYS Education Dept.'s website in English and Spanish. Parents or persons in parental relation should contact the District's Director of Special Education, Donald Cassidy, at 516-434-5180. Referrals in writing should be sent to the Farmingdale UFSD Special Education Department, 50 Van Cott Avenue, Farmingdale, NY 11735.

Emergency Closing / Delayed Opening of School

Arrangements have been made to notify the general public whenever schools are to be closed or if there is to be a delayed opening because of weather conditions. Parents of students will receive a telephone call from the ParentLink System. Please ensure that your contact information is up-to-date by contacting your child's main office. Closings and delayed openings will also be posted to the District Website: www.farming-daleschools.org. Announcements will also be made on News 12 and local radio stations.

IN THE EVENT OF A DELAYED OPENING, THE **UPK PROGRAM**MORNING SESSION WILL BE CANCELLED FOR THAT DAY.

Health Services

New York State Law requires written proof of the following immunizations: Kindergarten through Grade 1: 4-5 doses DTP/aP, 3-4 doses Polio, 2 doses MMR, 3 doses Hepatitis B, 2 doses Varicella; for Grades 2 - 5: 4-5 doses DTP/aP, 3 doses Polio, 2 doses MMR, 3 doses Hepatitis B, 1 dose Varicella; for Grades 6 - 7: 3 doses DTP/aP, 1 Tdap, 3-4 doses Polio, 2 doses MMR, 3 doses Hepatitis B, 2 doses Varicella; for Grade 7 only: 1 dose of Menveo or Menactra; for Grades 8 - 12: 3 doses DTP/aP, 1 dose Tdap, 3 doses Polio, 2 doses MMR, 3 doses Hepatitis B, 1 dose Varicella; and for Grade 12 only: Booster dose of Menveo or Menactra. Students transferring from a parochial school to a public school are considered new entrants. Acceptable proof of immunizations must be from a doctor or NYSIIS. Parental history is not acceptable. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO SCHOOL IF IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT MET.

AS PER NEW YORK STATEWIDE SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES, any child who comes to school with a "medical assistive device" such as crutches, splints, ankle boots, immobilizers, casts or wheelchairs, requires a doctor's note/order to be in school with that specified device.

Continuing Community Education

Farmingdale maintains one of the most extensive continuing community education programs on Long Island. A publication describing the various course offerings is mailed to district residents early in August and early in January of each year. Information about registration procedures and schedules is included in the course offerings publication. For additional information, please contact the Director of Continuing Community Education at 516-434-5316 between the hours of 9 am to 1 pm and 6 pm to 9 pm on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays (while classes are in session) and Thursdays and Fridays 8 am to 4 pm.

<u>Senior Citizens of Farmingdale, Inc.</u> is sponsored by Farmingdale Public Schools Continuing Community Education and the Incorporated Village of Farmingdale. The program is open to school district residents over 55 years of age and has regular meetings every Wednesday (except the 3rd Wednesday of each month) from 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm at the Farmingdale Public Library on Merritts Road when school is in session. Working Papers

The School District cooperates with the NYS Labor Dept. in issuance of working papers required by law for students under the age of eighteen who seek employment. All children who are residents of the district and who have the need for such papers should complete an application form obtained from the High School Health Office (516-434-5229). To secure working papers, a student must show proof of a physical examination within the last year and submit proof of age. For employment as a newspaper carrier, special applications and permits are available at the Howitt Middle School.

Farmingdale CARE

CARE is a private, non-profit corporation which provides before-school, after-school, summer care and pre-kindergarten education in the elementary schools. For information, please call 516-434-5599.

Free or Reduced Price Meals

Students whose families meet the financial criteria set by the government may receive free or reduced price meals. Applications can be obtained at your child's school and should be completed and returned as soon as possible. All applications will be reviewed for approval.

Pesticide Notification

Education Law requires that all schools establish a pesticide notification procedure. Part of that procedure includes establishing a registry of names and addresses of people that wish to be notified prior to any application. Although the school district does not use pesticides, there may be an occasion where we have to. If you wish to be placed on the notification registry, please contact Nelson Dominguez, Office of Districtwide Operations (516-434-5150). Asbestos Abatement Notification

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires that all schools establish an asbestos notification plan. Part of that plan includes posting a 10 day notice at the building where abatements are planned. For further information contact the Districtwide Operations Office at 516-434-5150.

Student Information and the Military

The Patriot Act obliges the district to provide student directory information to military recruiters unless parents have signed an opt-out request and sent it to the guidance office. Parents of juniors and seniors will receive a copy of the opt-out form in September by mail. The deadline for return is September 30.

Non-Discrimination

The Board of Education of the Farmingdale Union Free School District does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, creed, religion, marital status, gender, age, disability, military status, genetic predisposition, carrier status or sexual orientation in the educational programs and activities that it operates, or the employment therein. In addition the Board of Education of the Farmingdale Union Free School District does not discriminate in accordance with the **Dignity for All Students Act**. This Law has been designed to protect students from harassment/bullying that impacts the learning environment.

Title IX / ADA 504

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Education of the Farmingdale Union Free School District, Farmingdale, New York does not discriminate on the basis of gender, race or disability in educational programs and activities which it operates, that is required by Title IX of the Federal Education Amendments of 1972, and the regulations implementing the same not to discriminate in education programs and activities extends to employment therein and the admission thereto and that inquiries, complaints or grievances concerning the application of Title IX harassment issues and ADA/504 Regulations must be referred in writing to Glen A. Zakian, Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources and Administration, 50 Van Cott Avenue, Farmingdale, NY 11735 or the Director of the Office of Civil Rights, U. S. Department of Education, 75 Park Place, New York, NY 10007. All complaints of violation of these regulations will be investigated and, if necessary, hearings held and actions taken to bring about an equitable resolution.

Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act (FERPA)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that the District, with certain exceptions, obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information from your child's education records. A student's parent(s) or eligible student has the right to inspect and review the student's records within forty-five (45) days of the day that the District receives a request for access.

The right of a student's parent(s) or eligible student to consent to disclosure of certain information contained in the student's education records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent for: 1) information the District has received prior written consent of the student's parent(s) or the eligible student to disclose, 2) directory information unless a student's parent(s) or eligible student has opted out, as defined in this section of the calendar; or 3) under limited circumstances certain other information as permitted by the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

The right of a student's parent(s) or eligible student to seek to amend parts of the student's education record which s/he believes to be inaccurate, misleading or in violation of the student's rights. The student's parent(s) or eligible student should write the school principal (or appropriate official) clearly identifying the part of the record they want changed, and specifying why it is inaccurate or misleading. If the school decides not to amend the record as requested by the student's parent(s) or eligible student, the school will notify the student's parent(s) or eligible student of the decision and advise him/her of the right to a hearing regarding his/her request for amendment. Additional information regarding the hearing procedures will be provided to the student's parent(s) or eligible student when notified of the right to a hearing.

As stated above, the District may disclose appropriately designated "directory information" without written consent, unless you have advised the District to the contrary in accordance with District procedures. The primary purpose of directory information is to allow the School District to include this type of information from your child's education records in certain school publications. Examples include: District's Newsletter; school or local newspapers; athletic programs; musical or theatrical programs; District website; news releases; annual yearbook; honor roll or other recognition lists: classroom videotapes that the New York State Education Department requires for permanent teacher certification; and graduation programs. Directory information, which is information that is generally not considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released, can also be disclosed to outside organizations without a parent's prior written consent. Outside organizations include, but are not limited to, Farmingdale Youth Council and its affiliated organizations, Farmingdale Public Library, Farmingdale PTA, Farmingdale CARE, and companies that manufacture class rings or publish yearbooks. In addition, two federal laws require local educational agencies (LEAs) receiving assistance under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA) to provide military recruiters, upon request, with three directory information categories—names, addresses and telephone listings—unless parents have advised the LEA that they do not want their student's information disclosed without their prior written consent.

If you <u>do not</u> want the District to disclose directory information **for the 2016-2017 school year** from your child's education records without your prior written consent, you must submit a written request each year to the Superintendent of Schools. Failure to make such request shall be deemed consent to release, provide, or publish the directory information.

The District has designated the following information as directory information:student's name, address, telephone listing, electronic mail address, photograph, date and place of birth, major field of study, dates of attendance, grade level, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, degrees, honors, and awards received, the most recent educational agency or institution attended.

The right of any person to file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Education, Family Compliance Office if the Farmingdale Union Free School District violates FERPA.
