GATES MILLENNIUM SCHOLARS	Students are eligible for the GMS Scholarship if they are African-American, American Indian,/Alaska Native, Asian Pacific Islander American or Hispanic American. Must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the U.S., GPA of 3.3, (87 approximately) enrolling as a full-time student in an accredited college or university, demonstrate leadership abilities through community service, extracurricular or other activities. Student must meet the Federal Pell Grant criteria. Have all three required forms submitted (Nominee Personal Information Form, Nominator Form, and Recommender Form) by the deadline. YOUTH HUMANITARIAN AWARD In Memory of Stanley Marcus	This award is available to both Junior and Senior high school students. Criteria includes outstanding volunteer community service and for having displayed humanitarian principles by word and deed. Winner will be selected for the quality of humanitarian activities rather than for the quantity of extra-curricular activities.
