<b>BOSTON UNIVERSITY</b> Boston, MA  <b>37th Annual Trustee Scholarship</b>	In order to be considered for the Boston University Trustee Scholarship <b><u>you must be nominated by the Principal of the school.</u></b> Students are usually in the top 5-10% of their class and demonstrate exceptional records of service and activity in their schools and communities. Criteria for judging are character, personality, academic achievement and potential teaching ability. <b><u>You must be nominated by your counselor.
