Secondary Summer School Registration Fee

The registration fee must be paid at time of registration (cash or check please). Again this year, our Secondary Summer School Program will ONLY be offered to Farmingdale School District Residents.

Registration Procedures, Monday, June 29th

Grades 11 & 12.....9:00 – 11:00 AM
Grades 9 & 10.....12:00 – 1:30 PM
* Grade 8..... 12:00 – 1:30 PM
(Grade 8 students may register for Spanish 1 only)

1. Students and parent or legal guardian should report to Farmingdale High School, Cafeteria B, during the time period assigned to your grade. If it is absolutely impossible for a parent or legal guardian to be present, then the student **MUST** bring written parental permission. Students are also required to bring school ID or a driver's license for identification purposes.
2. High School student registration is dependent upon approval from the HS Guidance Counselor and School Principal, Mr. G. Zakian. Middle School approval for Spanish 1 requires the written consent of the student's guidance counselor.
3. Students who are not attending Summer School classes but wish to take an August Regents in any of the following: Comprehensive English, Math, Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, U.S. History, and Global Studies or an RCT in Reading, Writing, Math, Global Studies, U.S. History and Science **MUST REGISTER** on Monday, June 29th to insure exam placement.
4. Pending enrollment, the following is a list of courses that may be offered this summer: Classes run from 8:00AM-12:50PM (Grades 9-12 may take up to three classes).

**8th grade students may take Spanish 1 only if they fail the State Proficiency examination in June. Passing summer school will fulfill the one year high school requirement. Spanish 1 is open to all high school students who previously failed the subject.*

***Students who failed Math 3B may take Intermediate Algebra for credit in place of 3B during the summer. However, Intermediate Algebra cannot be used toward acquiring an Advanced Regents Diploma. In the Fall 2009 term, students pursuing an Advanced Regents Diploma must take Algebra 2 and Trigonometry, as Math 3B will no longer be offered.*
