WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the community to provide such relief to the Cold War veterans of the District;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Farmingdale Union Free School District elects to participate in the exemption of RPTL Section 458-b, subdivision 2, paragraphs (a) and (b);

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that pursuant to RPTL Section 458-b, subdivision 2, paragraph (a), subparagraph (ii), the Board of Education of the Farmingdale Union Free School District adopts the fifteen (15%) percent exemption, which amount shall not exceed the statutory basic maximum set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 128, OF THE LAWS OF 2017, EFFECTIVE JULY 25, 2017, THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE AMENDED SUBDIVISION 5 OF SECTION 457 OF THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW TO EXTEND THE PURCHASE DATE FOR NEWLY CONSTRUCTED PRIMARY RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY BY FIRST TIME HOME BUYERS TO UP THROUGH AND INCLUDING DECEMBER 31, 2022 IN ORDER FOR SUCH HOME BUYERS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SAID PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION; AND

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE FARMINGDALE UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT HEREBY APPROVES THE GRANTING OF SUCH PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR FIRST TIME HOME BUYERS, PURSUANT TO THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW, SECTION 457.
