Mr. Goldberg continued, stating that the Board of Education was interested in encouraging members of the public to share their ideas, comments and questions. Feedback and questions should be directed to the Board's email account at boe@farmingdaleschools.org. Questions and comments would be responded to by members of the central administrative team and would be publicly reviewed at the next regular Board meeting. Mr. Goldberg thanked everyone for their anticipated courtesy and cooperation. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Superintendent's Board of Education President Michael Goldberg introduced the Superintendent of Schools and asked for his monthly update. Mr. Defendini began with a review of the events surrounding the opening of school. He thanked the members of the Farmingdale public schools as well as the entire school community. He reflected on the final weeks of the summer when town hall meetings addressed the reopening plans and the concerns around the 2020-2021 school year. He noted that the month of September became a time of settling down and settling in; school certainly looks different than the norm, but teachers and students are now stepping up to the plate to move forward. Mr. Defendini spoke about the small changes that are happening, including the opening of the Green and White Shop, that are actually a big deal. Plans are underway for the annual Halloween parades.

Mr. Defendini went on to discuss the protocols and procedures that were in place and have now been put to use as COVID cases have been diagnosed. He reviewed the contact tracing efforts conducted by our nurses. He discussed the decisions to close schools as a response to the timing of the notification of a positive case; information received early enough in the evening can allow the custodial staff to do a more comprehensive cleaning process in affected areas. If the notice comes in the morning, the district will close based on the best interest of students and staff.

Mr. Defendini spoke about the schoology initiative. He noted that new technology creates new learning curves. Parent workshops are currently being developed in order to allow for the continuing understanding of this program which will allow for uninterrupted instructional opportunities.

Mr. Defendini concluded his update with an announcement that families would begin to see additional reopening steps over the next few weeks, including the restart of clubs and extra curricular activities. Mr. Defendini thanked the many people who have participated, led and focused an extraordinary level of effort to allow Farmingdale Schools to return to our usual extraordinary home.
