Call to Order

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mr. Goldberg, President of the Board of Education. In accordance with Governor Cuomo's Executive Order related to temporary modifications to Public Officers Law, the meeting was conducted in a virtual format to allow for the uninterrupted continuation of our important work. The Board meeting notice indicated that access to the meeting would be posted on the district's website at www.farmingdaleschools.org and a live feed would be available on www.youtube.com.

Meeting reconvened in public session at 8:00 p.m. Board President Michael Goldberg opened the meeting with the following statement:

Pursuant to Executive Order 202.1 (and subsequent orders closing District schools) issued by the Hon. Andrew M. Cuomo, Governor of the State of New York, signed March 12, 2020, and due to the concerns of the Board of Education for the Health and Safety of the community emanating from the current COVID-19 pandemic, there would be no in-person public access to the board meeting and instead the meeting would be live streamed and recorded. Access to the live stream could be had by accessing the school district's website for a link that will bring you to a youtube site and the recording of the meeting can be accessed on www.farmingdaleschools.org. In addition, the public participation portion of the meeting was suspended by board resolution.

Mr. Goldberg continued, stating that the Board of Education was interested in encouraging members of the public to share their ideas, comments and questions. Mr. Goldberg thanked everyone for their anticipated courtesy and cooperation. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Superintendent's Update

Board President Michael Goldberg introduced Superintendent of Schools Paul Defendini and asked for his monthly update. Mr. Defendini began with an update on the education system during COVID. He stated that it is the district's belief that students are better served in a live instructional environment. There are challenges in the remote learning environment. Mr. Defendini discussed the yellow zone designation in some other communities based on their rise in infection rates. Farmingdale has not been identified in this way. It is not clear if the state metrics are based on geographic regions, village boundaries, town lines or even school districts. Mr. Defendini provided an overview of the testing protocols if we were to be identified as a yellow, orange or red zone.

Mr. Defendini went on to talk about some of the fun things that are happening around the district, including athletic intramural programs, clubs across the elementary, middle and high school; the high school musical rehearsals are in place. We are keeping our Farmingdale traditions alive, including the holiday concert Hallelujah chorus. While many of those traditions may look a little bit different, they are still happening.

Mr. Goldberg thanked Mr. Defendini and the entire staff for their efforts.

The Legislative Action Committee met to set priorities to present to our elected officials. The Chamber of Commerce had their installation dinner. Mrs. Lively will serve as the Vice President of this organization and Mrs. D'Amico will serve as a director. Mr. Defendini was presented with the Chamber's Presidents' Award in recognition of the work he has done for the community.

Mrs. Lively reported on the New York State PTA Convention, which took place on November 14, 15 and 16. The program was conducted in a virtual environment; the business of the conference was completed; resolutions, by-laws, elections of officers and workshops were all provided to the attendees.

Mrs. Lively reported on the Farmingdale Youth Council. The December meeting had been cancelled; the next meeting is scheduled for January 19. Mrs. Lively will serve as President of the Youth Council this year.

Mr. Espinosa spoke of the National Honor Society induction. Students were in attendance and families were observers in the virtual room. Mr. Hughes, Farmingdale High School Social Studies teacher, was the keynote speaker. Mr. Espinosa went on to say that he was extraordinarily impressed with the Albany Avenue reunification process that had taken place due to a school COVID shutdown.

Mr. Espinosa added that the Massapequa Farmingdale Men's Club was holding a toys for tots program. Toys will be accepted at Papallardos. Mr. Espinosa attended the Farmingdale Library trustee meeting. Staff are working in teams in order to prevent co-mingling of the staff, which will help to keep the library open. The hours have changed slightly; virtual services are available. There is a winter loan program that allows for books to be borrowed until February 28.

# Items for Discussion

Draft Policy and Regulation #6700, Purchasing Board President Michael Goldberg introduced Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources and Administration Glen Zakian and asked for a Policy Committee update. Mr. Zakian stated that the Policy Committee worked on updating the language that was in the current policy. Assistant to the Superintendent for Business Michael Motisi stated that most of the updates were related to the changes in regulations for the piggy banking of contracts from other public entities. Piggy backing allows for cost savings, and the policy reiterates best practices under General Municipal Law as it defines lowest responsible bidders. Mr. Zakian stated that the policy would be added to the consent agenda at the January meeting.
