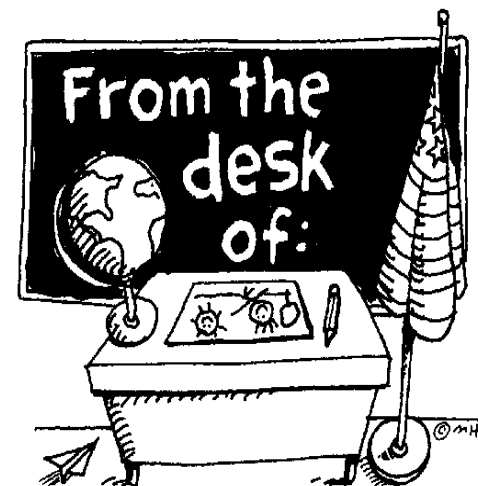

Registration Procedures

Tuesday, July 2, 2019

1. Students and parents or legal guardians should report to Farmingdale High School, Cafeteria B, during the time period assigned to your grade. If it is absolutely impossible for a parent or legal guardian to be present, then the student **MUST** bring written parental permission to register. Students are also required to bring school ID or a driver's license for identification purposes. Students attending private schools must bring a letter, on school letterhead, signed by their home school Principal stating their summer course and exam requirements and their student ID with photo.
2. Students who are not attending Summer School classes but are taking an August Regents, **MUST ALSO REGISTER** on Tuesday, July 2nd to ensure exam placement.
3. Pending budgetary considerations and/or class enrollment, the following courses may be offered during the summer. Individual classes are 60 minutes in length. Students may take up to 4 classes.
